¹ A South Carolina birth certificate costs \$12, and you must show one of the following documents before getting a birth certificate: any unexpired driver's license or ID card issued by a state DMV office, a current school or employer picture ID, an unexpired military ID, an unexpired passport, or an unexpired weapon or gun permit issued by federal, state or municipal government. Birth certificates from other states cost between \$10 and \$30, and have their own ID requirements.
